## What is Proposition 1

**Proposition 1 is a transformative investment in Seattle's aging transportation infrastructure for mobility, safety, and sustainability.**

The **Seattle Transportation Levy will fund \$1.55 billion over 8 years in transportation improvements** to pave streets, fix bridges, build sidewalks, connect communities to light rail, and create new walking, biking, and rolling routes where people want to go. Proposition 1 will replace the existing Transportation Levy, which provides about 30% of Seattle Department of Transportation's (SDOT) funding, and expires at the end of the year.

Prop. 1 is funded through property taxes, costing an additional \$18.58 a month for a \$804,000 median value home. Assistance is available for low-income households. Prop. 1 will have independent public oversight for accountability.

## Investing in Safety and Connections for All

### **Bridge Maintenance and Improvement - \$221M**

Keeps our existing bridges in good and reliable condition.

### **Sidewalks and Pedestrian Safety - \$193M**

Builds 350 blocks of new sidewalks, crossings, and curb ramps where they are needed the most.

### **Vision Zero, School & Neighborhood Safety Improvements - \$160.5M**

Reduce traffic collisions on Seattle's most dangerous streets and improve transportation safety near schools and in our neighborhoods.

### **Transit Corridors & Connections - \$151M**

Connect people safely to new Link light rail stations— as well as improve bus rider experience, and speed up buses.



## Investing in Our Communities

### **Major Street Maintenance and Modernization - \$403M**

Repave and improve streets that carry the most buses, trucks, and cars and make it safer for everyone to walk, roll, bike, and ride transit.

### **Climate and Resiliency - \$69M**

Address the climate crisis by reducing air pollution and make sustainable transportation options more available
